Affordability is inherent in the success of this community which thrives on sharing and exchange among its members. The "topography" of the Common Green draws inspiration from Portland's dynamic natural context in the form of an undulating wooden landscape that weaves itself through the site to form interior and exterior communal spaces. Private homes that surround the Green are reduced to family areas, sleeping quarters, and **inventive storage** opportunities to maximize efficiency and encourage socialization in the condominium-type arrangement. The strategic use of green technology allows storm water and sunlight to be used proactively for on-site **sustainability**. With a fresh aesthetic, this prototype serves as a unique addition to the existing urban fabric and benefits from a full range of accessibility.

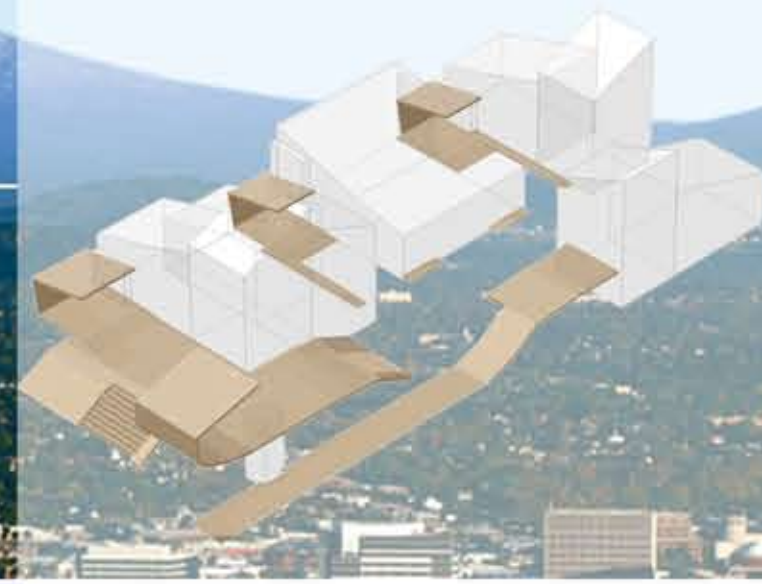
